Surveyed the first day of March 1777 by Charles Lukens the then deputy Surveyor of the district for Adam Ruthanburger by virtue of his order of Survey bearing date the third day of April 1769 & no. 776 which will appear by the original Draft remaining in my office at Sunbury & surveyed by obl. the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Novbr. 1792 by virtue of the above recited order agreeable to the old lines containing three hundred eighty four Acres & thirty four ps. & the usual allow<sup>ce</sup>.
