

Situate in Greenfield Township, Blair County (formerly Bedford) first surveyed in 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Sill, dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794, for 400 Acres of Land and not returned. Resurveyed for Joseph Kemp and Samuel Calvin, the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 1846, and contains Four Hundred and nine Acres and one hundred and fifteen perches and the usual allowance of six Percent for Roads &c.

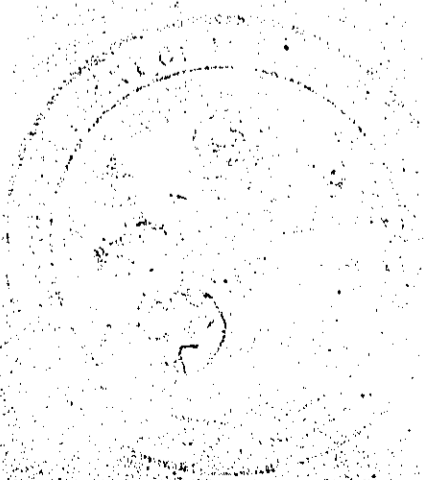
