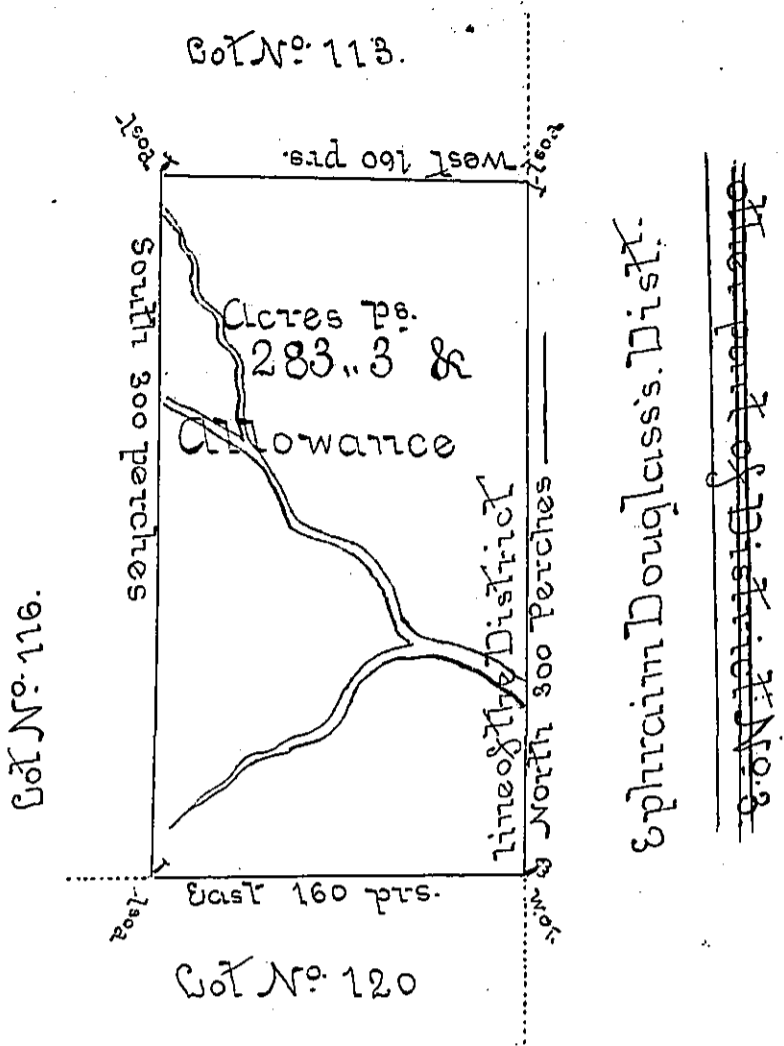

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Bukens Esq<sup>r</sup>: Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup>: the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783. The above tract of land containing two hundred and eighty three Acres and three Perches and Allowance of six P<sup>r</sup>: Cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup>: was Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1783 by
