



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain Lot of ground in the Town of Curwensville in the County of Northumberland, being numbered in the general Plan of said Town Sixty Four, and granted to James Tilghman Esqr. containing in Breadth North and South fifty seven feet six inches and in Length East and West Two Hundred and Thirty feet, bounded Eastward by River Alley Northward by Lot number Sixty Three Westward by Broad Way and Southward by Shamokin Street, as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
