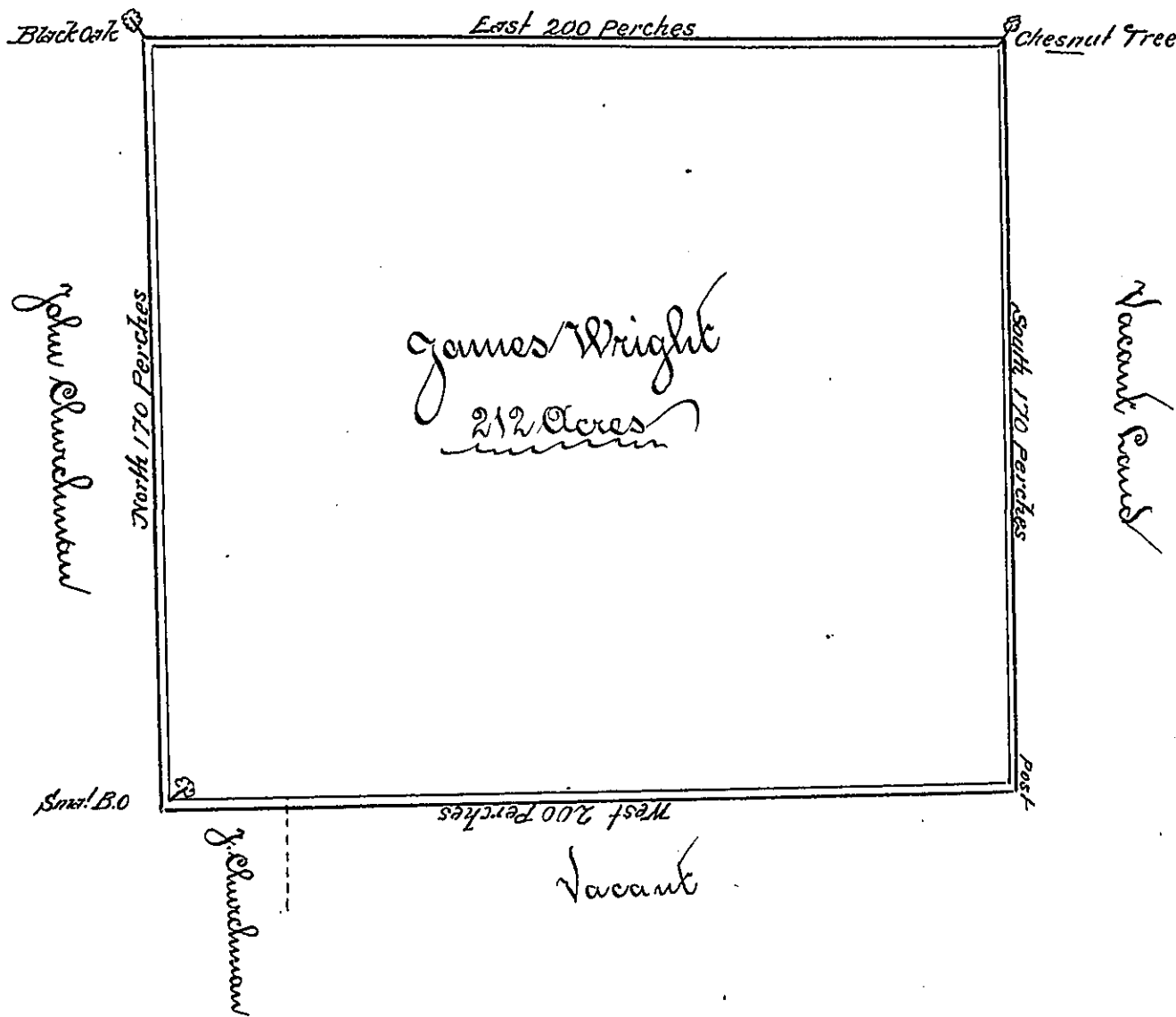


Vacant Land



By Virtue of a Warrant from ye Prop^r Comm^{rs} Dated ye 19th Day of November 1715
 ye Surveyd to James Wright a Certain Tract of Land ^{situate North} of Warrington in Chester County

Beginning at a Small Black Oak standing in the line of John Churchman thence
 North by ye said Churchman's Land one Hundred & Seventy perches to a Black Oak
 thence East by Vacant Land two Hundred perches to a Chestnut Tree thence South
 by Vacant Land one Hundred & Seventy perches to a post thence West by a line of
 marked Trees two Hundred perches to ye place of Beginning containing two Hundred
 acres with ye allowance of six 1/2 Cent

Surveyd and layd out by ye Surveyor Genl's Order the 17th Day of April 1716
