Nathaniels Tract of 614 Acres thence South South West 39 perches to a post standing in ye Division line of the County thence in sd line north 85 deg: west 103 perches to a black oak thence north north west 250 perches to a post thence East north East 113 perches and a half to a post thence South South East 250 perches to ye first mentioned post
