



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in White Hall Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania, containing Sixty four Acres and 50 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was Surveyed unto Daniel Traxel on the 24th November Anno 1756. In pursuance of a Warrant granted by the Double Proprietaries unto George Hoffman, Dated on the 22^d February Anno 1754 — who conveyed his Right to the said Warrant unto the said Daniel Traxel (al. Troxel) on the 16th May Anno 1759 to whom it had been Surveyed. By Order of W^m Parsons, Esquire. The said Daniel Traxel afterwards, as on the 8th November 1752. — Sold and conveyed his Right to the same unto the present Possessor — John Deoth — — Drawn for him on the 29th March Anno 1773.
