



A Draught of a Tract of Land called _____ Situate on the Waters of Shamokin Creek and also on the head branches of Gravel Run which leads in the Easterly side of the North Easterly Branch of Susquehanna adjoining land claimed by Thomas Lemon on the said Run and on the Path leading from Fort Augusta to Claytons Copper Mine on Tearing Creek about six or seven Miles from Fort Augusta formerly in Rocks but now in Northumberland County containing three hundred and six acres and a half of an Acre surveyed the 28th Day of September 1772 for Reuben Hoines in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15th Day of October 1771.
