 A survey was made on the 5th of July following of a certain lot of Ground in the Town of Dunbury
 in the County of Northumberland, numbered in the general Plan of s^d Town Thirty seven
 and granted to George Eichelberger (who hath assigned the same to Tho^s Hartley Esq.) con-
 taining in Breadth East and West sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred
 and thirty feet bounded Eastward by Lot number Thirty eight Southward by Barberry alley
 Westward by Lot number thirty six and Northward by Shamokin street aforesaid as by the
 general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
