

The above is a draught of a tract of Land called Fairfield, situate in Washington County on the waters of Raccoon Creek ~~southeast~~ containing 400 ac. 36 1/2 survey'd July 9th 1785 for Sho's Cherry in pursuance of a certificate from the Virga Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia & Ohio, and regularly entered as will appear from the following Certificate. Surveyor's Office of Monongalia County State of Virga Feb. 25th 1785. Sho's Cherry produced a Certif from the Comrs for adjusting Claims and settling Titles to Lands in ye. Counties of Monongalia, Monongalia and Ohio for your hundred Act of Land in this County on Raccoon Creek to include his Settlement made in ye year 1774.
