



The above is a draught of a survey made the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Daniel Henry dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794 situated on the Waters of the Doshanock Branch of Beaver Creek in Allegheny County in the second and third Donation Districts containing four hundred acres and allowance of six per centum to be called Moorefield.
