



A Draught of a Survey called the Hermitage, lying on Harmans run in Washington County, contg. 349 ac. & 92 ps. strict measure executed Dec. 14th 1785 in Pursuance of a Certificate in the name of Jno. Christ for 400 ac. granted him by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virginia to adjust the Titles to unpatented Lands in ye. Counties of Honougalia, Yohg. & Ohio, and regularly entered with the County Surv^r as appears from ye. authenticated List of Entries transmitted from the Surveyor Genl^s Office.
