



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of May Anno. 1748. granted to Frederick Kern. The above described Tract of Land Situate in Heidelberg Township in the County of Northampton Province of Pennsylvania Containing one Hundred and Thirteen Acres and five Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads was Surveyed for the said Frederick Kern, on the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of December, Anno. 1756.
