



These may Certify the Generall Surveyors office that Pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of Edward Shippen Griffith Owen & James Logan the Prop<sup>r</sup> and Govern<sup>r</sup> Commiss of Prop<sup>r</sup>ty and the Seale of the Provin<sup>s</sup> bearing date the 22<sup>d</sup> of the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1701

I sworeid to James Chevers two hundred acres of Land in ye Manner of Rocklands and County of Chester Begining at a Hickory standing in Concord Line thence North 24 deg; West in the 1<sup>st</sup> Line ninety five perches to a black oak thence North 81 degrees West in the Line of Birmingham Township 239 perches to a white oak thence South South East 220 perches to a post thence East North East 206 perches to the first mentioned Hickory

Surveyd the 31<sup>th</sup> of December 1701
