 Acres, and Surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1843. And  
 No. 2. on Warrant granted to Wm Allen on the 4<sup>th</sup> day  
 of May 1843. for five Acres, Surveyed May 9<sup>th</sup> 1843. Con-  
 taining together nine Acres, one hundred and sixty six  
 perches, and allowance of six per cent. Situate in Lower  
 St. Clair Township Allegheny County.
