



On the Warrant granted George Hoyer the 9<sup>th</sup> of August 1784 for locating "Six acres of land adjoining the land of John Benton about 4 miles from Burnham" I have surveyed to Michael Grouse the above described tract containing three acres & a quarter (with the allowance of six<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cent) on which is an improvement made about the time of the said date where in the said Grouse now lives situate in Nockamixon Township Bucks County
