Begins at a post in a line of William Euan's Land thence East North East by Vacant Land fifty Six pches to a Chestnut Tree thence North North West by the Land of the S<sup>d</sup> Thomas Hubbert one Hundred forty four pches to a post thence West South West by the Same Land fifty Six pches to a post thence South South East by the Land of the S<sup>d</sup> William Euan, one Hundred forty four pches to the place of Beginning Containing fifty acres. — Surveyd the 10<sup>th</sup> of Febr 1728.
