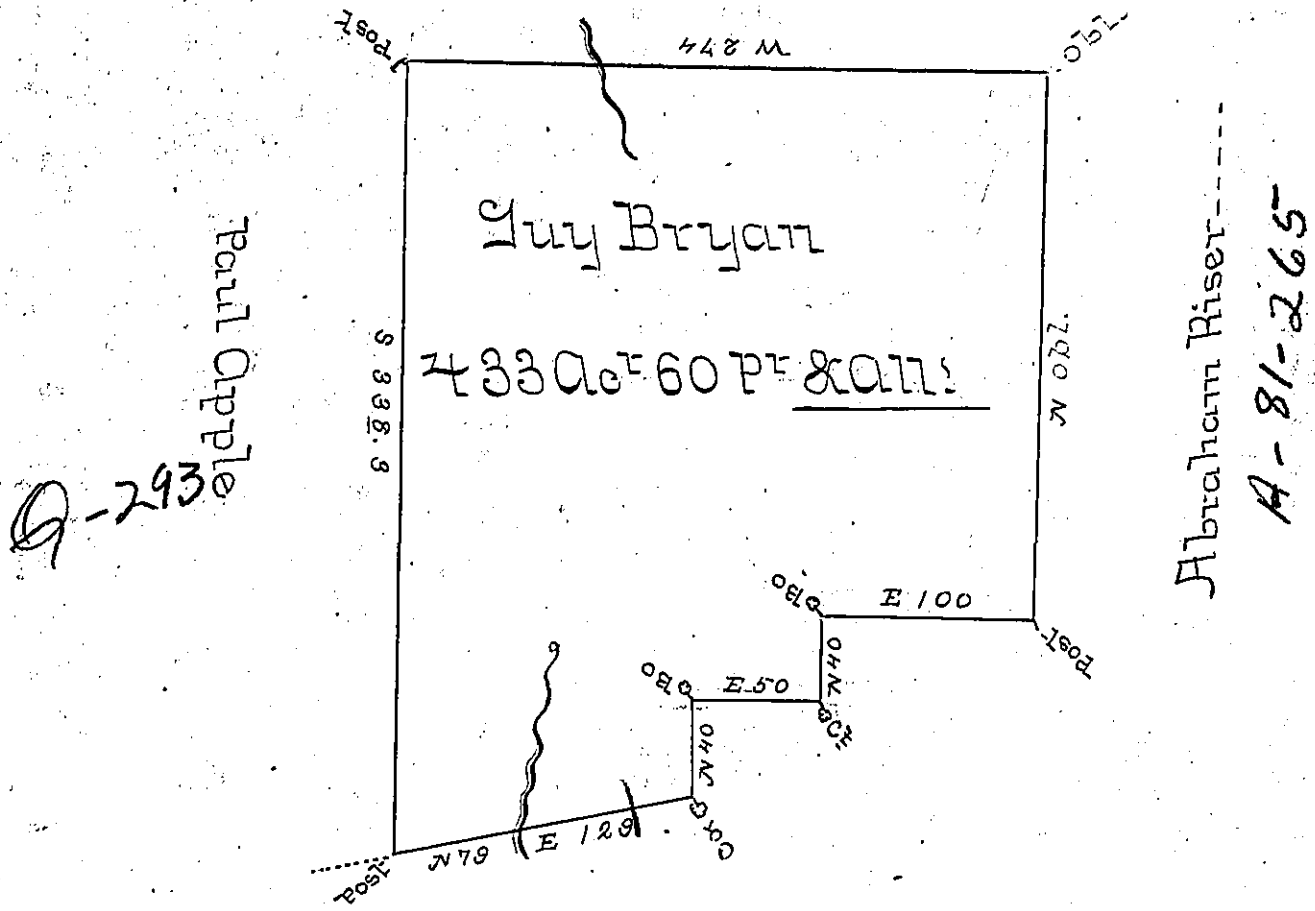


The Bottom of Fishing Creek



By Virtue of a Warr^t dated 26 Aug^t 1793 Surveyed the 30th of December 1798 Unto Guy Bryan the above described Tract of Four hundred and thirty three Acres & 60 perches of Land & all. Situate on the waters of Fishing Creek & adjoining Paul Apple and Abraham Riser now of Berwick late Wioning Township & described to be Luzerne County but in fact in Northrd County nearly on the line—
