



A draught of a survey executed the 27th April 1799 for Eli Allen by Thomas Stokely on a warrant granted to said Allen for 400 acres dated the 11th day of October 1787. Corrected and calculated the 4 day of September 1810 by leaving 35 acres and 38 perches out of the original survey which is ^{or interference} lap of Hugh Mc Conkey done at the request of ^{sd} Allen, containing 322 Acres and 73 perches and allowance of 6 Per Cent
