 of Henry D Drinker and others) containing three hundred  
 and eighty six acres, forty two perches and the usual allow-  
 ance for Roads. Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1794, in pur-  
 suance of a warrant dated the <sup>24th day of January (?)</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1794.
