



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the May 4th Twenty ninth 1734 Surveyed unto Griffith David a tract of Land Situate on the South Side of Tohickon Creek in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Willow Tree on the Bank of the said Creek thence by Vacant Land South East Twenty six perches and by Land laid out to David Cameron one hundred and Thirty four perches to a post a Corner of said Camrons Land thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and ninety perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North West two hundred and ninety perches to a post on the Bank of said Creek thence up the same to the place of Beginning Containing Three hundred acres with the usual Allowance of six p Cent Surveyed by 24th 1734
