Called Mill Pond, containing Forty acres <sup>One hundred perches</sup> ~~one half~~ <sup>sixteen</sup> perches and allowance of six p<sup>er</sup>ct, Survey Ap<sup>pr</sup>il 2<sup>d</sup> 1762, 1766.
