



In Pursuance of Three Warrants directed to my Father and myself one bearing Date the 19<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 1747. one the 19<sup>th</sup> August 1746 & another the 20<sup>th</sup> March 1753. The above was survey'd for James Patterson in Parcels viz: the first 40<sup>a</sup> & allowance of 6<sup>a</sup> per Cent. The second 67<sup>a</sup> & allowance & the 3<sup>d</sup> 31<sup>a</sup> & allow<sup>wa</sup>nce making in the whole 138<sup>a</sup> & allowance as above: which are here all described in one Draught the Survey whereof was Completed the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>mo</sup> 1753. Situate part in East Nottingham & part in Oxford Township; Chester County laid down by a scale of 60 P. to an Inch
