



A draft of a tract of land situate in Friends Cove Colerain Township Bedford County containing two hundred and five acres & allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 5th day of December 1783 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Doddridge & John Cessna dated the 6th September 1762. No 1 represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Wmth M^o Clay dated the 1st day of June 1762. It intersects with the Joseph Doddridge & John Cessna tract. William M^o Clay conveyed to John Cessna J^r who had bought from Joseph Doddridge & John Cessna. John Cessna J^r devised the same to his heirs who conveyed to William Cessna & George Deitel, the present owners & occupiers
