A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County containing one hundred & forty eight Acres & thirty two perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Examined & calculated the 24th of February 1831. (From Drafts of recent Surveys made upon the Ground) In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Moorehead bearing date 15th of December 1768 and on an Order of the Board of Property bearing date the 23^d of February Instant.
