



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3 day of July following for James Parr on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked on the General Plan of said Town Number Ninety one containing in Breadth North and South fifty Seven feet and Six inches, and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broadway, Southward by Lot Number Ninety two, Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot Number Ninety. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1774. for Adam Hauerling by Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> February 1774.
