


Land late of John Read

for Jacob Neff and Jacob Baum in Right of George and David Read, (it being part of a Larger Tract of 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ A^s & Allowance. Formerly Surveyed unto the said George and David Read by Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 24th Day of September A.D. 1754 ~
