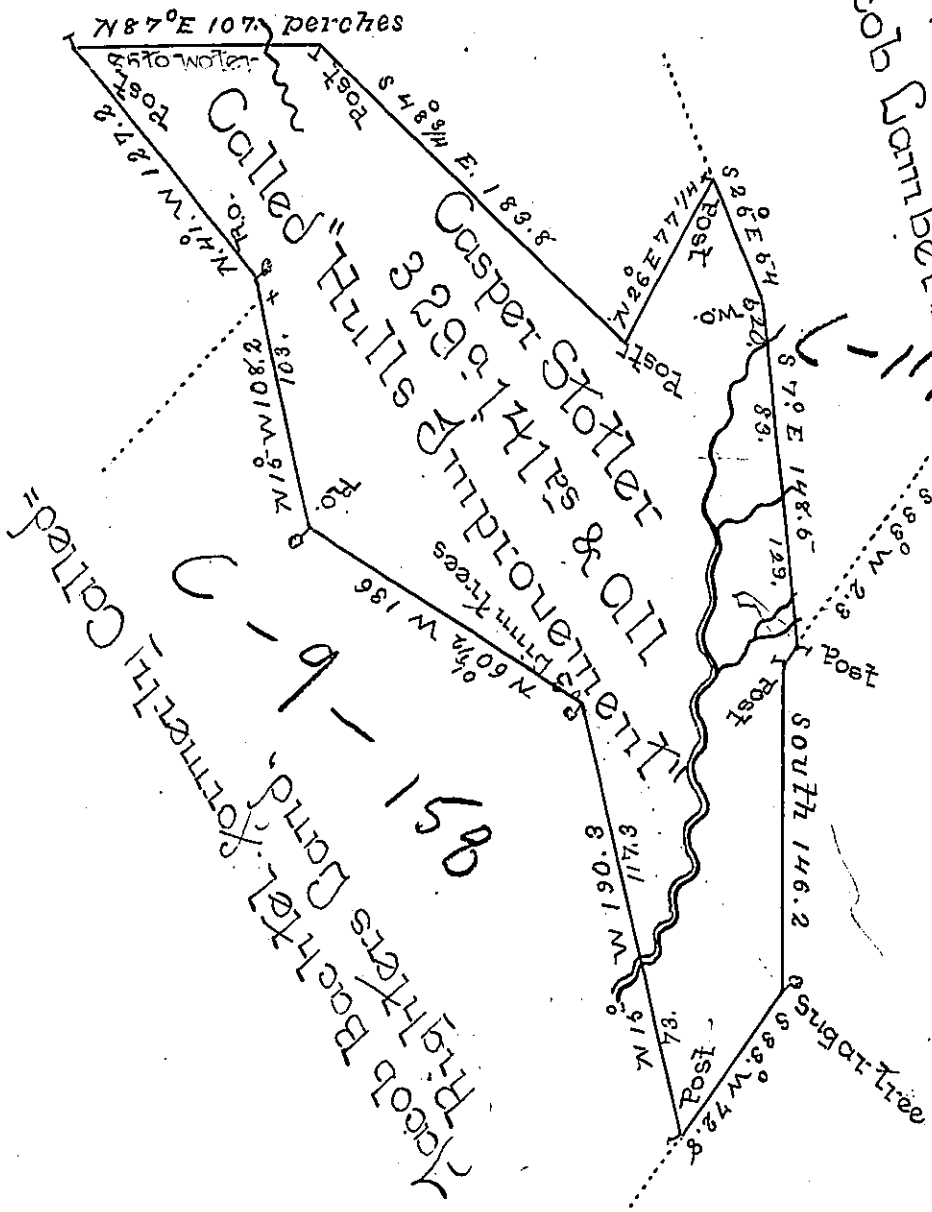

Situate on the Waters of Stoney Creek including Hulls Improvement so called, in Stoney Creek Township Somerset County, (late Bedford) and was surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1793 for John Rhodes in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1793: a dispute ensued, Stotler obtained Hulls Improvement right, quieted Rhodes's claim by purchasing his Warrant, and the land is now returned surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Casper Stotler dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of January 1794 for 300 acres at 50.00 hundred, during the interest the 1<sup>st</sup> March 1775. which I believe to be the date of Hulls first Improvement.
