



The whole survey containing 300 acs of the Allow^{ce} claimed by John Barclay on his Warrant dated July 20th 1797 - (1797)

The colored space south of the lines marked C.D.E. claimed by Zedoe Wright A. Ladock Wright's old Imp^o 17 Poles distant from the Dogwood Corner and 7 Poles from the line S 6° W -

But a new field claimed by Ladock Wright 16 Poles from the Dogwood Corner - C.D.E. said by Zedoe Wright to be an agreed line between him & John Barclay - John Barclay's House 15 poles from the line D.E. which line runs near John Barclay's orchard fence, and includes part of a Grain Field -

A Drought of a Survey called "Camperdown" situate on the Waters of Peters Cr. in Allegheny County, containing 300 acs and the usual Allow^{ce} executed on the 29th of April 1799 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Barclay for 300 acs dated July 20th 1797 - and the disputed part delineated in consequence of Special Instructions for that purpose from the Surveyor Gen^l. dated March 20th 1799.
