

of an acre of land
of six per cent. Situate in District No 6 in the late Purchase
on the East side of the Allegeny River; adjoining William
Willink and others No 2680 by virtue of a warrant to William
Willink Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Seghers,
Hendrick Hollenhoven and Rijck Jan Schimmelpennink
of Amsterdam No 2697 dated the 12th Day of December
1792.
