



A Draught of a survey situate on Monongahela in Washington County Call'd The River Dart Containing 347 3/4 Acres of Land and the Usual Allowance of 6 per Cent surveyed December the 18th 1787 In pursuance of Order No 575 granted to Joseph Yates for 300 Acres of Land on the West Side of Monongahela River opposite the Mouth of Little Redstone Creek Dated April the 3rd 1769 David England enters a Cave against this Survey alleging that the Location in Jos Yates Name does not call for the Land & that the equitable Right is in Him.
