



Situated on both sides of the State Road, and including the Cross Roads leading from Casper Skelton's to Berlin, in Stony Creek Township (Bedford now) Somerset County, and surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of October 1799, by John Wells Deputy Surveyor, in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December 1793. — Certified the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September 1803.
