



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Lower Saucony Township, in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing forty four acres and 64 perches of Land, together with the usual allowance at six per Cent. for Roads.

That was formerly surveyed by Nicholas Scull Junior for Godfrid Bremer, by virtue of a warrant of the 12^d March Anno 1752. and now resurveyed unto Christian Baughman, in Pursuance of a new warrant granted to him by the Honble the Proprietaries Dated at Philadelphia on the 25th Day of January Anno 1764.
