



By virtue of two Warrants both dated the 4th December 1792 surveyed the 5 July 1793 to Samuel Brink the above described tract of land situate on a branch of Big Spring brook being a branch of Sawkill in Upper Smithfield Township in the County of Northampton containing One hundred and seventeen acres and the allowance of six per Cent &c. Claimed by Francis J. Smith and is included in his return on Andrew Russels Warrant of the 12 July 1793 of 320 1/2 acres
