



Draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Sangascootach Creek Bald Eagle Township Centre County containing three hundred and eighteen acres and seventeen perches and allowance of six per cent &c. surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1830 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Michael Quigle Henry Cook and Conrad Grove for 300 Acres, dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 1830.
