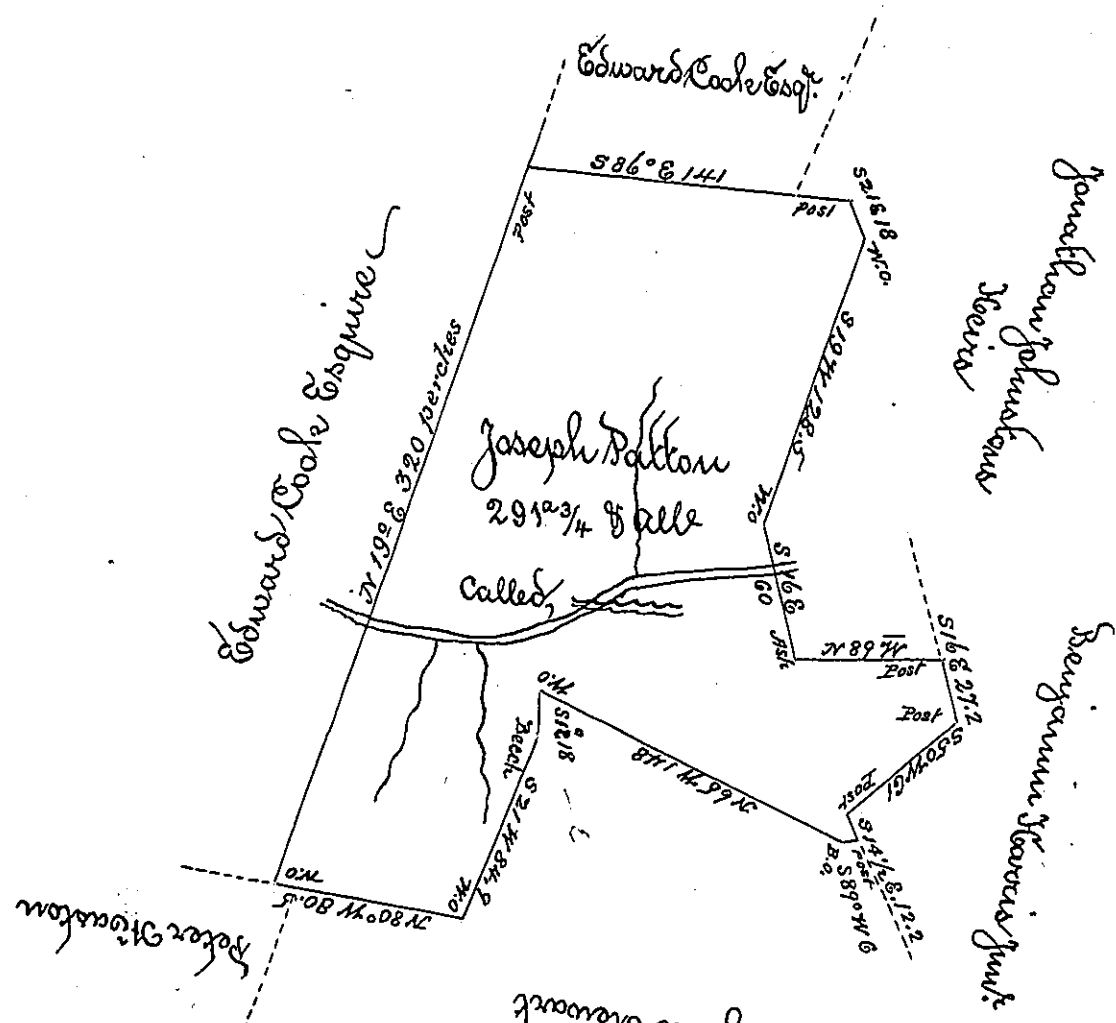


The dispute was settled
