



Draft of a Tract of Land called Battions Grove situate on the Easterly Branch of Bankicke Creek on the South side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna in the County of Centre about one Mile from the same containing Two hundred and Ninety five acres Eighty six Perches and the usual allowance of six per Centum for Roads Surveyed for Richard Battion the Ninth Day of July 1869 by Charles Stewart Esq deceased then Deputy Surveyor in Pursuance of an Order of Survey bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1869 certified this 27<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1801.
