



In pursuance of an Order 710771 Dated the fourth Day of August 1766 surveyed the 13th Day of Septem^r 1766 for the Reverend Doct^r William Smith the above Described Tract of Land situate on the South side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniata nearly opposite to the Standing Stone between Lands of William Hussey and Samuel Finley containing one hundred fifty three acres and thirty one perches and the usual allowance of six acres & cent for Roads &c.
