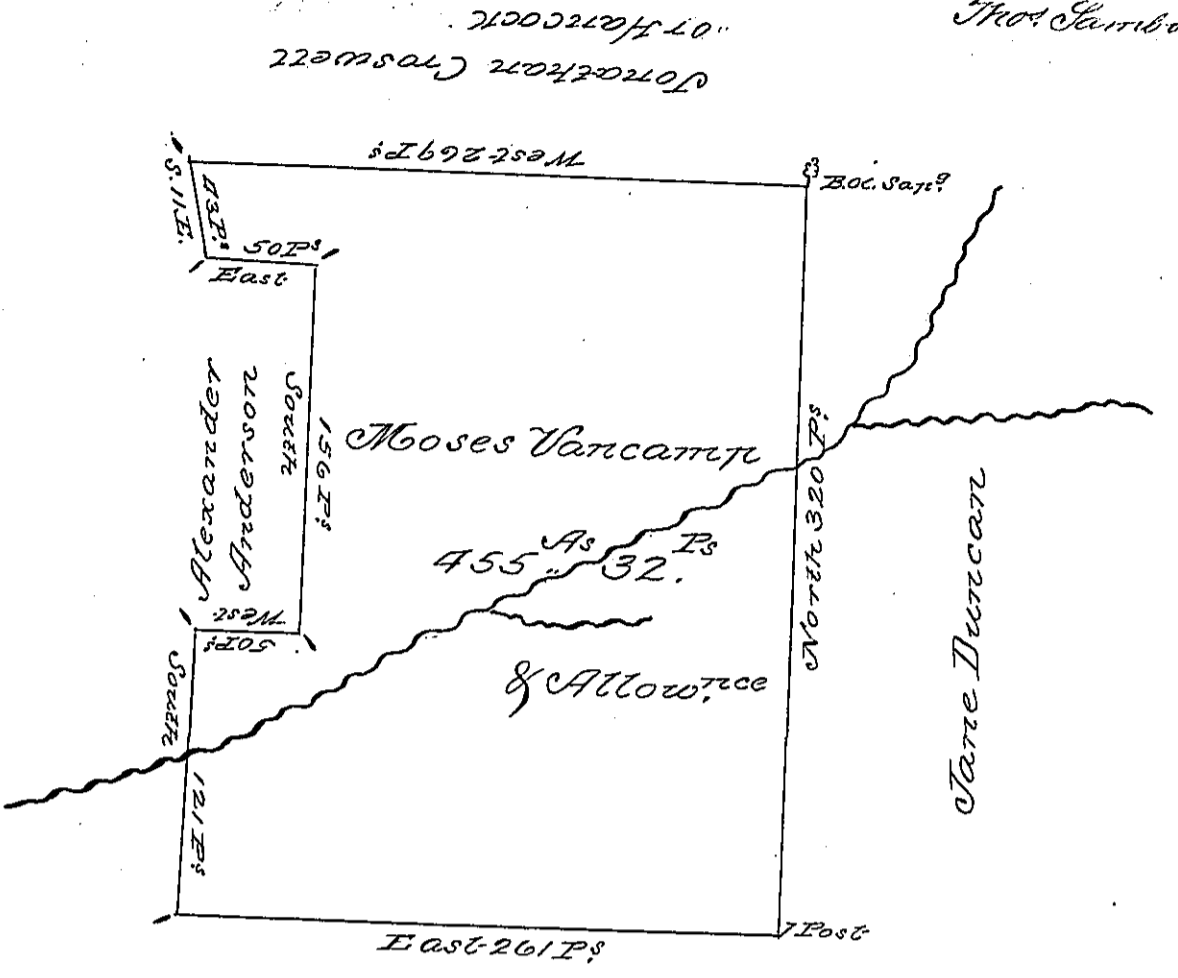


16. B. Setting Plan of the County rec'd from Mr. Carothers Case D. J. P. (066) - Tract of 26
