



Situate in Franklin late Monaghan township York County containing as above set forth ^{as} 1448 1/4 perches and allowance being part of a larger tract of 1848 1/4 ^{as} 131 perches and allowance of land which was surveyed on the 1st day of December A.D. 1813. In pursuance of a warrant for 173 ^{as} granted to Jacob Geiselman bearing date the 15th day of June A.D. 1798. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the said 1st day of December, A.D. 1813, and at the request of the present owner Henry Miller the same is returned for confirmation the 2^d day of May A.D. 1814.
