



A Draught of a Survey of ~~22~~ 97 1/2 Acre of Ground of 6000 ft. Situate in New London township, Chester County on Elk River Granted to John Scott Esqr. by Warrant Dated 11th. May 1756 and soon after surveyed to him by George Churchman, but thro some oversight or miscarriage the Field Work was mislaid & forgot - the above John Scott bequeathed the Land by Will to his Nephew Tho: Scott who has had it in peaceable possession a Number of Years & has since conveyed it to Mr. Shearer, Resurveyed 1st 4th Mo. 1785
