



In pursuance of two Warrants to me Directed, one Dated the 30th. day of August 1784 for fifty acres the other dated the 14th. day of September 1784 for forty acres unto Frederick Dieder. By virtue of the said Warrants I did survey for the said Frederick Dieder <sup>three quarters</sup> Eighty one acres <sup>perches</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> fifteen of Land with allowance of Six P.C. in part hereof in the Township of Harford in the County of Chester in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Agreeable to the above Draught. Witness My Hand the 13th. Day of September 1784.
