



The above is a draft of the land of Aaron Hackney dec<sup>d</sup> (Patented to John & Jehu Hackney) agreeable to a survey made by me for Alex<sup>t</sup> McArthur Esq<sup>r</sup> in Ap<sup>r</sup> 1819. on warrant to Aaron Hackney dated <sup>1st</sup> March 1787. and on order of Board of Property dated 30 May 1829. The above resurvey was made for the purpose of throwing off two small interferences at A and B and taking in about 9 acres of vacant land at C with a view to have the patent corrected accordingly. The yellow lines represent the resurvey as made by M<sup>r</sup> McArthur for M<sup>r</sup> McArthur <sup>many years ago</sup> and as returned by myself in 1819 and the red lines represent the lines of an earlier survey, upon which, through some mistake, the patent was issued.
