



The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land called Mount Pleasant, Situate on the waters of the Chest Creek; adjoining and below Lands surveyed for Richard Finney, Charles Bough and John Kersoe, and about 1/2 miles N.E. of the Old Trading Path in Cumberland County; Containing Three Hundred and Fourteen acres and Twenty two perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 1769. for Alexander Murray In pursuance of an Order No 2620. Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769.
