



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract Situate on the head Waters of the north Branch of Clearfield Creek including some of the waters of the Chest Creek adjoining lands surveyed for the Hon^{ble} the Proprietaries Samuel Fisher George Emelen Thomas Rodney Daniel Robinson & Land claimed by Patrick Nugent about four miles Westward from the upper or great Clearfield about a mile and a half South West of that part of Alexander Stewarts Tract at the Chest where the old Trading path from Frankstown to the Kitzanning first crosses the line of said Tract in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and twenty eight acres and the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 15th day of June 1772 for Benjamin Bezzerson in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27th Day of April in the same year by
