



Situate in Fawn Township in the County of York, being part of two larger Tracts of Land, the first of which was originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 7th day of the 2^d Mo. 1742 (and said to be returned) In Pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey granted to Patrick Scott & James McCrough bearing date the 6th day of January A.D. 1742. And the other was surveyed for Hugh Whiteford on the 19th day of the 12th Mo. 1769 by the said Matthews late D.S. (and by him said to be returned) In pursuance of a warrant for 130 A. dated the 21st day of August 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tracts of Land on the 13th day of September A.D. 1806. And now at the request of the present owners the Elders and Trustees of the State Ridge Congregation, we are desired to make return of the Draught, In order that a Patent may be obtained for the above Lot of Land
