Divided off from the residue March 24th. 1813. for Tobias Starry for the use of — Stay caught, and the small triangle containing 71 ps Fall, which was not included in the original survey by Geo Stevenson D.S. but is vacant & in possession of Tobias Starry I have laid down with it that it may be patented with the other if consistent with the rules of the office
