



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Long Swamp Township in the County of Berks (late Philadelphia) in the Province of Pennsylvania, Containing Forty seven acres and 27 perches of Land together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly surveyed unto Conrad Fisher, in pursuance of a warrant granted to him by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries, Dated on the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of February, Anno 1745, who sold the same unto Jacob Tarter, who also conveyed the same unto his son Bernard Tarter. Resurveyed on the 2<sup>d</sup> April Anno 1766, By order of the Surveyor General
