



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Long Swamp Township in the County of Berks (late Philadelphia) in the Province of Pennsylvania, Containing Sixty one acres and twenty six perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads. That was formerly Surveyed unto Conrad Ficker, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries, Dated on the 18th Day of February Anno. 1745, Who sold the same unto Jacob Tanner, who also conveyed the same unto his son Bernard Tanner Resurveyed on the 2^d April, Anno. 1766, By order of the Surveyor General,
