



By Warrant from the proprietaries dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1734.

Surveyed on the sixteenth day of February 1734 To Christopher Duck a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a White Oak a Corner of Ulrich Stueffens land thence by land of Valentine Gratto South West fifty one perches to a White Oak a Corner of S<sup>r</sup> Gratto's land and by Vacant land the same course twenty four perches to a post. Thence by Vacant land North West two hundred & Eighty perches to a post. Thence by land of Christian Leeman North East forty eight perches to a post. Thence by land of S<sup>r</sup> Christian Leeman South East fourteen perches to a Corner post of David Youngs land. Thence by S<sup>r</sup> Youngs land of same course one hundred and thirty two perches to a White Oak. Thence by the S<sup>r</sup> Youngs land North East Twenty seven perches to a Hickory. Thence by land of Martin Heideboelle fifty four perches of same course by Ulrich Stueffens Eighty perches to S<sup>r</sup> place of Beginning. Containing one hundred acres with usual allowance.
